Refunds can only be issued if requested 1 week prior to the start of class. Refunds are not issued after a class has begun, nor are they possible when classes are rescheduled due to weather.

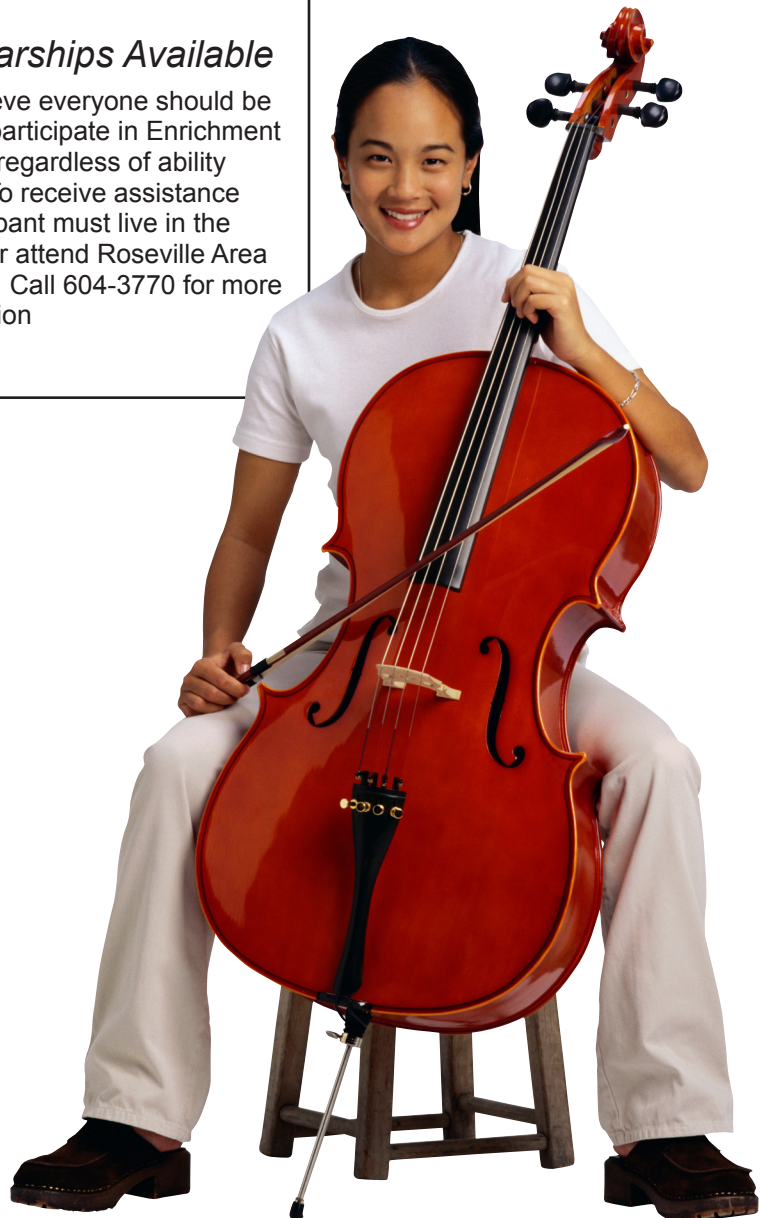
- * There is a \$5 service charge on participant initiated changes or cancellations.
