Policy 584 – Collection, Maintenance, Use and Release of Student Educational Data

- 1.0 Roseville Areas Schools collects, maintains, and releases information about pupils and their families only for legitimate educational purposes including instruction, guidance and research as provided in federal law and state statutes.
- 2.0 Philosophy
 - 2.1 Collection, maintenance and release of student information in the Roseville Area Schools is based on the premise that the welfare of the student and his/her family is primary and must be protected.
 - 2.2 Procedures for the collection, maintenance, and release of student personnel data shall be specified and be regularly reviewed to assure that such data is safeguarded and the privacy of the individual is maintained.

The policy and procedures regarding the protection and privacy of parents and students are adopted by the school district, pursuant to the requirements of 20 U.S.C., § 1232, et.seq. (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) 34 C.F.R., Part 99 and consistent with the requirements of the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minn. Stat., Chpt. 13 and Minn. Rules Pts. 1205.0100 to 1205.2000.
