SUBJECT: CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEES TO THE BOARD

1.0 Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to encourage the establishment of advisory committees involving citizens.

2.0 The School Board shall establish, at its discretion, advisory committees involving citizens to provide additional means of communication between the citizens of the community and the Board and staff of District 623.

2.1 Advisory committees shall be authorized by the School Board.

2.2 Such committees shall be identified as Ad Hoc or Standing. Ad Hoc advisory committees will deal with specific issues and then be terminated. Standing advisory committees are those that deal with continuing issues and are reestablished annually.

3.0 The Superintendent shall organize and inform the Board of advisory committees involving citizens, their proposed functions, membership composition, and relationship to members of the professional staff. The Board also will be informed of the persons appointed to such committees.

4.0 The Superintendent will provide an annual written report to the Board on all active committees.

5.0 Liaison between staff and advisory committees involving citizens shall be through the Superintendent, or a designated agent.

6.0 Rationale

The Board believes that the district makes better decisions with citizen input.
